Objective Imaging Ltd is fully committed to minimising and reducing our environmental impact across the scope of our operations and activities and through the products and services that we deliver to our customers.

We are fully committed to the core principles of environmental sustainability through identifying and addressing the environmental impact resulting from and associated with our activities, products and services.

Additionally, promotion of the conservation of natural resources is a priority consideration for the business in all its activities and we encourage our customers and partners to adopt environmentally sound policies and practices.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all activities, products and services of our company are performed in compliance with relevant environmental legislation and other requirements.

Specifically we are committed to :

- Reducing any environmental impact of our business activities
- Improving the environmental efficiency of our business facilities to reduce energy consumption and impact on other natural resources such as water usage, waste products etc.
- Compliance with environmental standards and regulation as well as in country legislative requirements.
- Improving energy and resource efficiency in the design, production and deployment of our products.

As a designer and user and seller of electronics and related technology we are specifically committed to support and actively promote the following guidance and standards :

WEEE

Objective Imaging is registered with the UK Environment Agency as a producer under SIC Code 26.51/1. Our Registration Number is WEE/CC5612UY. We will comply with the

requirements of WEE Regulations 2013 (Directive 2012/19/EU) particularly with respect to the requirement for safe and efficient recycling of EEE products at the end of their useful life. (See WEEE Compliance Statement for details).

REACH

We are fully compliant with the requirements of EU Regulation EC 1907/2006 which controls usage of SVHC chemicals as specified in lists provided by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA). (See REACH Compliance Certificate)

RoHS

We recognise and fully comply with EU Directive 2011/65/EU which controls the use and distribution of hazardous materials as previously utilised in the production of PCBs and Electronics. We only purchase our electronics (including PCBs from certified RoHS compliant manufacturers) and do not use any of the listed materials in our own manufacturing processes.

Conflict Minerals

We are aware and supportive of the initiative to eliminate minerals and metals originating in or processed by designated "conflict" regions of the world. We are working with our suppliers and customers to ensure that we never consciously use or sell products containing such minerals.
